Players qualify for a semi-final by playing in a club heat and obtaining a score in excess of 50%. Any player may play in a club heat, but to play in the semi-final they must be EBU members, have given the LCBA as their county of primary allegiance, and have not played in either the heats of the Tollemache, Corwen or Pachabo for another county during the current year. If a player plays in more than one club heat the first one will count unless they have notified otherwise before start of play.

Pairs will qualify to play in the final which will be an "all play all" playing at least three boards against each other pair.

The Management Committee will determine the number of pairs playing in the final according to the number in the semi-final. It will usually be 14 pairs. The first two or three pairs (depending upon EBU regulations current at the time) will represent the LCBA in the Corwen Trophy. In the event of a pair not being able to go, reserves will be invited down to and including those with a 50% score.
